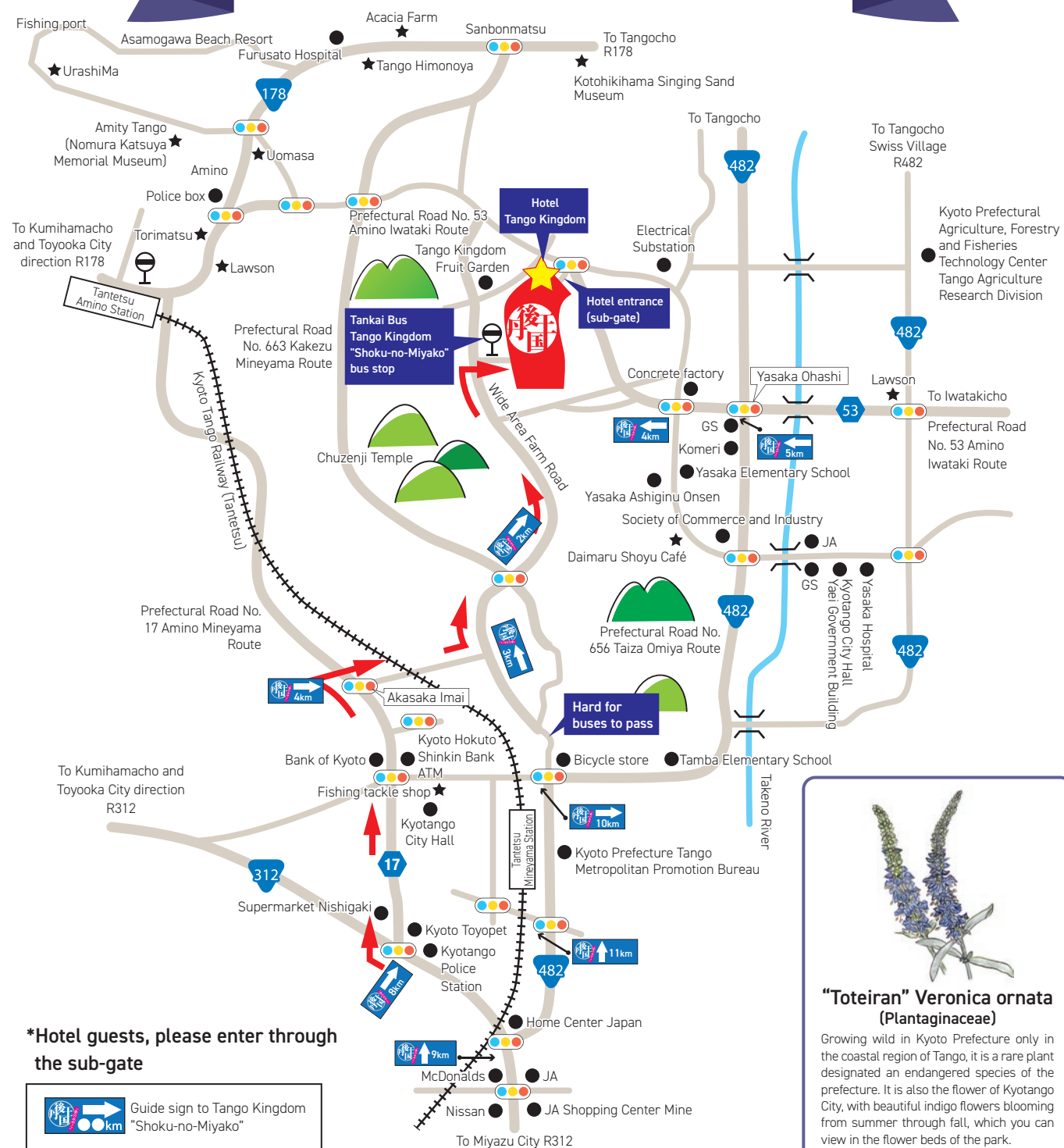


Tango Kingdom "Shoku-no-Miyako" surrounding area map

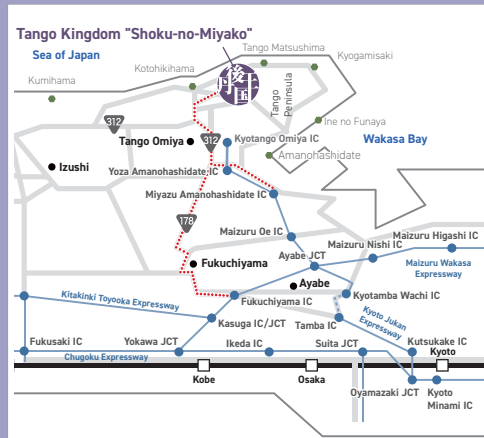


"Toteiran" Veronica ornata (Plantaginaceae)

Growing wild in Kyoto Prefecture only in the coastal region of Tango, it is a rare plant designated an endangered species of the prefecture. It is also the flower of Kyotango City, with beautiful indigo flowers blooming from summer through fall, which you can view in the flower beds of the park.

Access

- From Osaka
 - 【By car】 approx. 2 hrs 30 mins
 - 【By train】 approx. 2 hrs 50 mins (Tantetsu Mineyama Station)
- From Kyoto City
 - 【By car】 approx. 2 hrs 25 mins
 - 【By train】 approx. 2 hrs 30 mins (Tantetsu Mineyama Station)
- From Tomooka
 - 【By car】 approx. 1 hr
 - 【By train】 approx. 40 mins (Tantetsu Amino Station)
- Kyoto Tango Railway
 - From Amino Station by Tankai Bus (bound for Yasaka Byoin Mae): 30 min.
 - From Mineyama Station by car/taxi: Approx. 10 min.
- Kyoto Juukan Expressway
 - From Kyotango Omiya IC: Approx. 15 km (20 min.)
 - From Yoza Amanohashidate IC: Approx. 30 km (30 min.)
 - From Amanohashidate (Miyazu-shi): Approx. 30 km (35 min.)
 - From Kyogamisaki (Tango-cho): Approx. 30 km (35 min.)



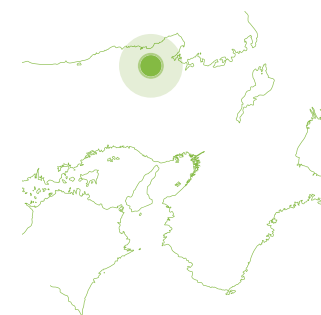

The Tango region is located in the northernmost part of Kyoto Prefecture, bordered by the Sea of Japan to the north and Hyogo Prefecture to the west. The coastal area (rias), where people can enjoy beautiful scenery, is designated as the Sanin Kaigan National Park and the Wakasa Bay Quasi-National Park. The Tango region is full of the romance of history, having both a series of ancient Japanese tombs and also having been home to the Tango Kingdom. Local industry includes traditional products like Tango Chirimen (silk fabric) as well as steel and machinery works. Local agriculture features widely known products like Tango Koshihikari rice, Kyotango pears, grapes, peaches, melons and more. Catches from the sea change with each season: red sea bream in the spring, flying fish in the summer, flounder in the fall and snow crabs in the winter. The Kumihama oyster farm is another major tourist attraction for the Tango region, in addition to sea bathing
